SMOKING PROCEDURES

Schoolcraft College recognizes the need to address the health and safety needs of the students, staff, and visitors from smoking, vaping, and the use of tobacco products.

Smoking is defined as the act of lighting, smoking or carrying a lighted or smoldering cigar, cigarette, or pipe of any kind. Vaping refers to the use of electronic nicotine delivery systems or electronic smoking devices such as e-cigarettes, e-pipes, e-hookahs, and e-cigars.

Students, employees, and visitors of Schoolcraft College are expected to observe all federal, state, and local laws, as well as College policy governing the use of tobacco products and electronic cigarettes.

Effective August 1, 2016, all Schoolcraft College campuses are smoke-free with the exception of use in private vehicles.

The enforcement of this policy is placed as a responsibility on all members of the College administration and Campus Police. Students, employees, and visitors are expected to comply with the smoke-free environment of the College. Persons who repeatedly disregard this policy will be subject to the appropriate disciplinary actions.
