

Michigan Transfer Agreement Requirements 2021-2022

Students at Schoolcraft can transfer to MTA-receiving four-year colleges or universities, and satisfy their lower level general education requirements by completing the MTA endorsement. To complete the endorsement, students must follow the course requirements below and complete all classes with a 2.0 or higher.

What are the Michigan Transfer Agreement Requirements?

Discipline/Subject	Minimum Credits	Course Requirements
English Composition	3	Select either ENG 101, 102, or 221
English Composition or Communications	3	Select a second course in composition OR communication arts
Humanities	4	Select two MTA courses from two different disciplines
Social Sciences	6	Select two MTA courses from two different disciplines
Natural Sciences	5	Select two MTA courses from two different disciplines
Mathematics	4	Select one mathematics course from the following categories: College Algebra, Quantitative Reasoning, or Advanced Level Mathematics
Minimum Total for MTA Credit Hours	30
